Dear Donna,

As yet another Tax Budget Cycle approaches, please find enclosed Values, Tax Rates, Levy Yields, and Levy Expiration dates as of this date for use in preparing your 2019 Tax Budget. When calculating 2019 levy yields, it is recommended that you use 98% figures from the enclosed Schedule B. Also attached is a separate enclosure detailing millage information and any levies you might have expiring.

All budgets must be advertised, public hearings held, and approved by the appropriate public entity by July 15th. Only one (1) completed budget form must be filed with the Auditor's Office no later than July 20, 2018, after which no further amendments are allowed. Per ORC, all submitted budgets must present actual revenue and expense for the previous two years, estimates for the current fiscal year, as well as projected budget figures for 2019.
